## Enquiry

A place will be offered in writing and held for you whilst you complete the enrolment requirements.



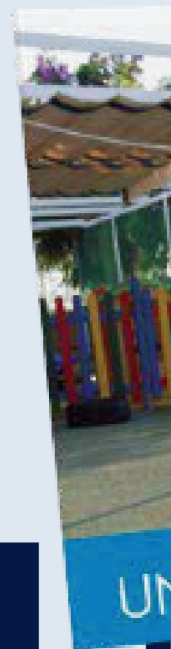
## Enrolment

# Vision & Values

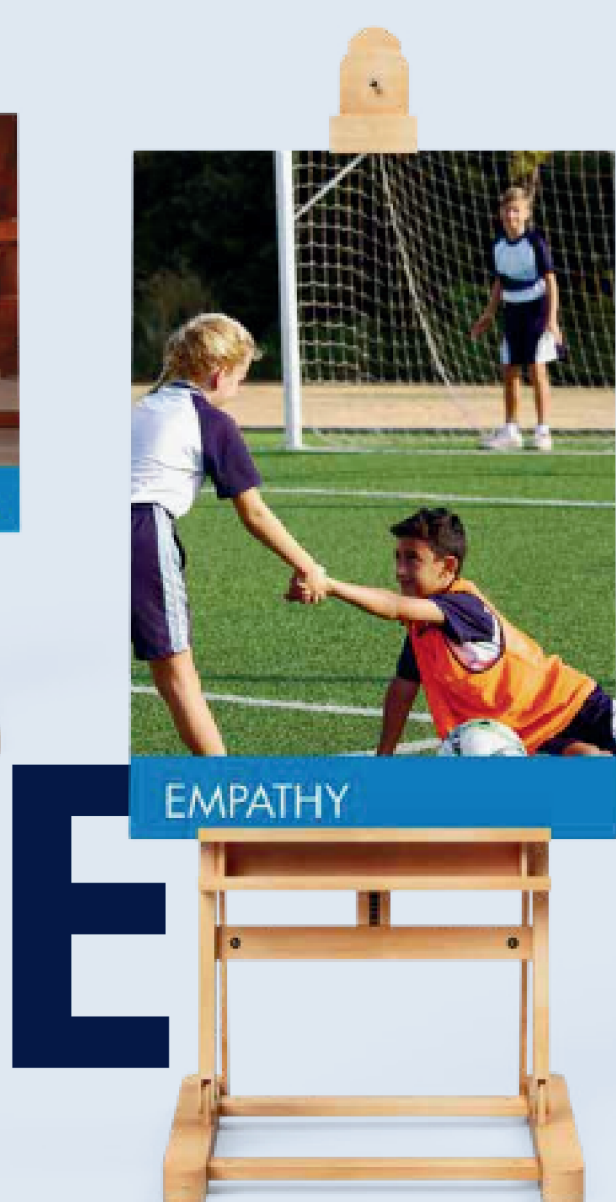
Our vision is that every child will achieve more than they imagined possible, in a happy and inclusive environment where everyone is supported and encouraged to excel.

# LEARNING

## Early Years Foundation

### Stage

NURSERY & RECEPTION

Through creative play, children develop language and personal, social and intellectual skills whilst exploring their environment and emotions. Within the seven areas of learning, teachers observe and assess children in order to create individualised programmes to enhance their learning experiences.

## Key Stage 1

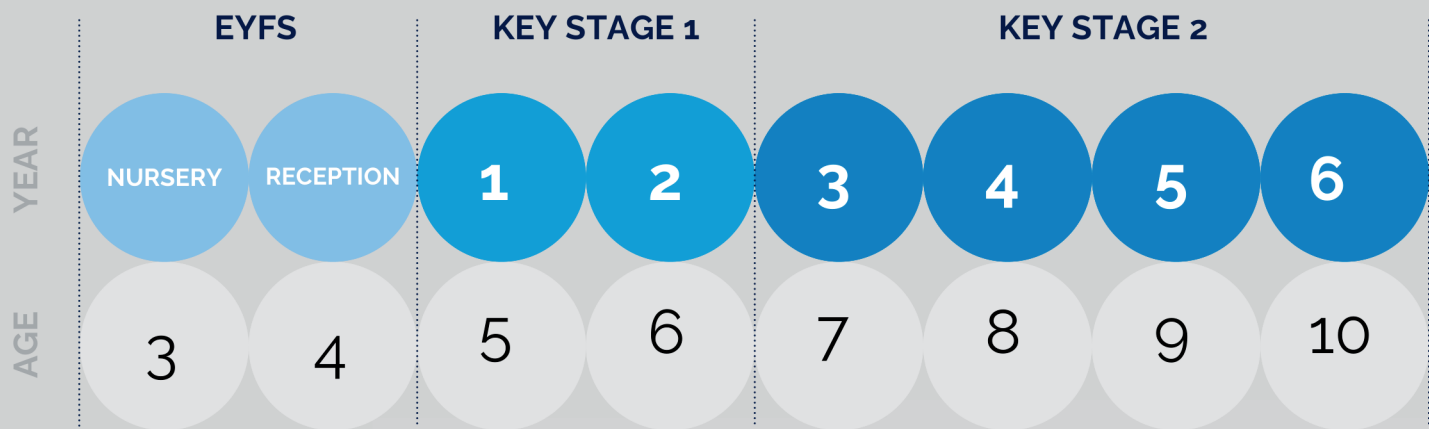
YEARS 1-2

Our intention at this key stage is to build secure foundations for learning as a platform for success. The curriculum is designed to balance both academic and creative subjects with breadth of study. Students are introduced to a range of new learning experiences whilst still being nurtured as young individuals at the beginning of their learning journey.

## Key Stage 2

YEARS 3-6

At this key stage, we are developing confident, independent learners. Depth of knowledge, skills and understanding continue to be developed through literacy, numeracy and project-based learning. Students have the opportunity to select a third language, which they will continue to study during their secondary education. Students take on extra responsibilities as members of the school community.





# JOURNEY

## Key Stage 3

YEARS 7-9

Students are given a strong foundation in the secondary curriculum by studying a broad range of academic subjects combined with PE, PSHE and Carousel (Music, Drama, Food technology, Robotics, Business Enterprise, First Aid).

We encourage our students to develop new skills and to understand how they can improve their learning.

## Key Stage 4

YEARS 10-11

Students study a core of Maths, English, Science, languages, PE and PSHE with optional GCSE subjects.

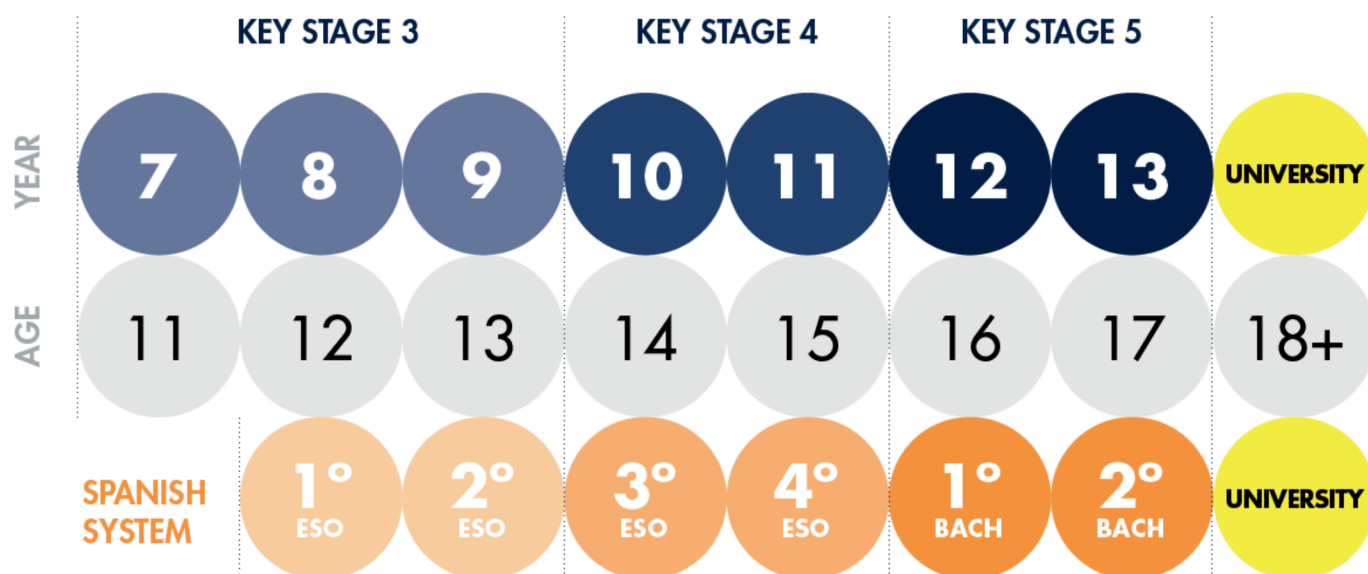
Students select optional GCSEs and enjoy in-depth learning tailored to their personal interests and strengths.

## Key Stage 5

YEARS 12-13

Students study a highly specialised set of subjects which reflect their university aspirations, and receive personal support for their future career choices.

They also participate in an enrichment curriculum and have the opportunity to take on leadership roles within school.



### 1º-2º

#### ESO

Students follow the Spanish ESO programme with a core of Maths, Spanish, Social Sciences and Natural Sciences together with some additional subjects (Drama, Food Technology, Robotics). Up to 65% of the subjects are taught in the English language so that students graduate with high levels of both English and Spanish.

### 3º-4º

#### ESO

Students follow the same programme but the percentage of subjects taught in English decreases slightly to prepare them for Bachillerato. In 4º ESO the students choose either Humanities or Sciences; both routes share core subjects: Spanish Language, History and English.

### 1º-2º

#### Bachillerato

Students have a choice of subject routes and the option to prepare for the Cambridge Advanced and Proficiency exams. As well as in-school assessments, students prepare for two Selectividad examinations at the end of 2º Bachillerato in order to increase their potential maximum grade to 14 points.



# Admissions Guidelines

Laude San Pedro International College is a non-selective school. We welcome applications for admission from pupils with a broad range of abilities, who will contribute to the life of the school and who will rise to the challenges of the Laude curriculum and our constantly evolving co-curricular programme. We aim to help our students to find their place within our school community, providing a number of specialised learning paths and supporting their different talents and aspirations. We advise parents of children with special educational needs and / or physical disabilities to discuss their child's requirements with the school before registering for a place as this will enable us to determine whether the school can make reasonable adjustments to ensure the child can flourish as a learner and both parents and school conclude that we can provide appropriately for the child's specific needs. English is both the language of communication in school and the language of learning. In order to make sure that all our students are able to access the curriculum, we will assess the level of English language of all our prospective students who do not have the required English level, we offer an intensive English programme to help them develop their language skills in order to be able to fully participate in the academics life of the school.

To enter into Year 12 all candidates should have at least 5 GCSE's with results 9 to 4 and with an expectation of a grade 6 or above in the subjects they would like to study for A Levels or equivalent. A high level of English (equivalent to C1) is required to enter into Year 12 as we do not offer English as a foreign language programme in Year 12 or Year 13.

Prospective students will be asked to provide their latest school reports and/or a reference person whom we can contact. Good behaviour, respectful demeanour towards teachers and peers and a positive attitude to learning are requirements we would look for in our prospective candidates in our effort to build a learning community with strong expectations.

## Conditions

- School fees are reviewed on an annual basis.
- Families will be required to confirm their places every academic year by paying the enrollment fee.
- The first academic term covers four months and is therefore the longest.
- Early payment discount applies to tuition fees.
- MEP classes may be a condition of entry for your child and will continue until the student is able to follow the curriculum at the appropriate level to the school's satisfaction.
- A 10€ charge will be incurred for any direct debits returned by the bank.
- 3% interest may be charged on any outstanding fees so we encourage prompt payment by direct debit to avoid extra charges.
- School fees include tuition, dining service, day trips, school materials and medical insurance (uniforms, photos and clubs/ECA, and other services are excluded).
- Text books and school material used remain the property of the School and are on loan to pupils. At the end of the Academic Year they need to be returned to the School.
- The School reserves the right to exclude or cancel the place of a child for the next academic year if there is any outstanding payment of fees.
- External examination fees are not included.
- For Years 11 and 13, school fees are paid twice a year.

## Discounts

- Sibling discount – the third child from the same family will receive a 10% reduction in the tuition and re enrolment fee. The fourth child and thereafter, will receive a 25% reduction in the same concepts.
- Advance payment discount – a discount of 3% will be applied to the tuition fees if paid in advance for the full year, before 31st July 2024.

## Payment Options for School Fees

Monthly: Invoiced on the 5th of each month.

Termly: 3 payments (31st August, 31st December, and 31st March).

Annual: A discount of 3% on tuition fees will apply if the 1 year payment is made on or before 31st July 2024.

Payments should be made by **direct debit**.

## Glossary

- Registration Fee for new students – The Registration Fee is a non-refundable, one-time payment, paid upon admittance of a new student.
- Enrolment Fee for new and existing students – The Enrolment/Re-enrolment Fee is a non-refundable payment, that secures your child's placement for the following school year.
- Tuition Fee – Payment to cover tuition costs for the student. Paid by trimester (3 payments), or annually (1 payment).

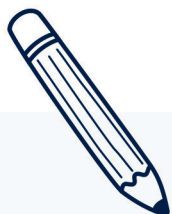
Fees have been calculated for round trips and will vary depending whether the journey is considered short or long distance (see above).
